Note: In October, 2017, the Southern Transportation Unit (STU) which accounted for 30 male beds at La Vista closed and became female bed capacity. In March, 2014, Male and Female vacancy percentages were added, with percentages backfilled until 7/2016. Starting in April, 2018, three columns that subtract RTP program beds from operational capacity have been added and figured into actual vacancy percentages.

Please note these figures are preliminary. They reflect the number of offenders added to the backlog compiled in the first few days of the following month. These figures change as offenders are removed from the backlog due to a court action such as an expungement order, stay order, set aside order, detainer, U.S. Marshal hold, future court date, awaiting sentencing on an additional case, completing misdemeanor sentence to a county jail, invalid mittimus, or an incorrect release from county jail. Conversely inmates are admitted retroactively via nunc pro tunc provisions. Therefore net admissions minus releases do not equal total inmate population change.

^a Fiscal year 2019 figures are preliminary until September 30th of the following year.

^b Fiscal year 2020 figures are actual through current month.

^c Projected change is a calculation determined by using a full year projection based on actual year-to-date date. In this calculation, a monthly rate is computed for each category (new court commitments, technical parole returns, etc.), and then the monthly rate is annualized by multiplying by 12; the annualized rate is used to calculate a change rate from last fiscal year to current fiscal year.

^d Other admissions include returns from a prior release to probation, court order discharge or appeal bond; interstate compact; and YOS terminations.

Mandatory Reparole: Reparoled on specific date set by Parole Board (includes S.B. 252 reparaes).

Sentence Discharge: Completion of sentence with no further supervision; now a combination of sentence and HB 1087 due to legislation passed in 2009.

Martin/ Cooper Discharge: Completion of sentence with no further supervision; sex offender subject to Martin/Cooper Supreme Court decision.

Charges/ Detainers Discharge: Completion of sentence, released to other law enforcement for pending charges or detainers.

Court Releases: Released by court to probation, releases by court order or released to appeal bond.

Deceased: Offender death on inmate status.
