INTRODUCTION

Dropouts are students who leave school and terminate their education prior to graduation. Students who are known to transfer to another public or private school are not dropouts. The dropout rate is an annual rate, reflecting the percentage of all students enrolled in grades seven through twelve who leave school during the reporting period.

Overall the 1987-88 dropout rate for grades seven through twelve is 4.1 percent. This is a decline from the 4.4 percent reported for 1986-87.

The dropout rate for grades ten through twelve for the same reporting period is 5.5 percent.

Of the total seven through twelve enrollment count, 3570 students or 1.3 percent were retrievals. These are students who had dropped out the previous school year but were back in the public schools for the 1987-88 school year.

This is the second report providing information on the number of students who drop out from Colorado's public schools in grades seven through twelve. The data is for school year 1987-88 and was collected for the reporting period of July 1987 through June 1988. The first report for school year 1986-87 was collected during two reporting periods; October 1986 through June 1987 and July 1987 through September 1987.

Although this report presents some tables with dropout data for both years, it does not offer a true comparison because the months of July, August and September are included in both reporting years.

The Colorado Department of Education plans to continue collecting dropout data from grades seven through twelve on a July through June reporting cycle. Future data collection will enable us to look at trends with 1987-88 serving as a base year.

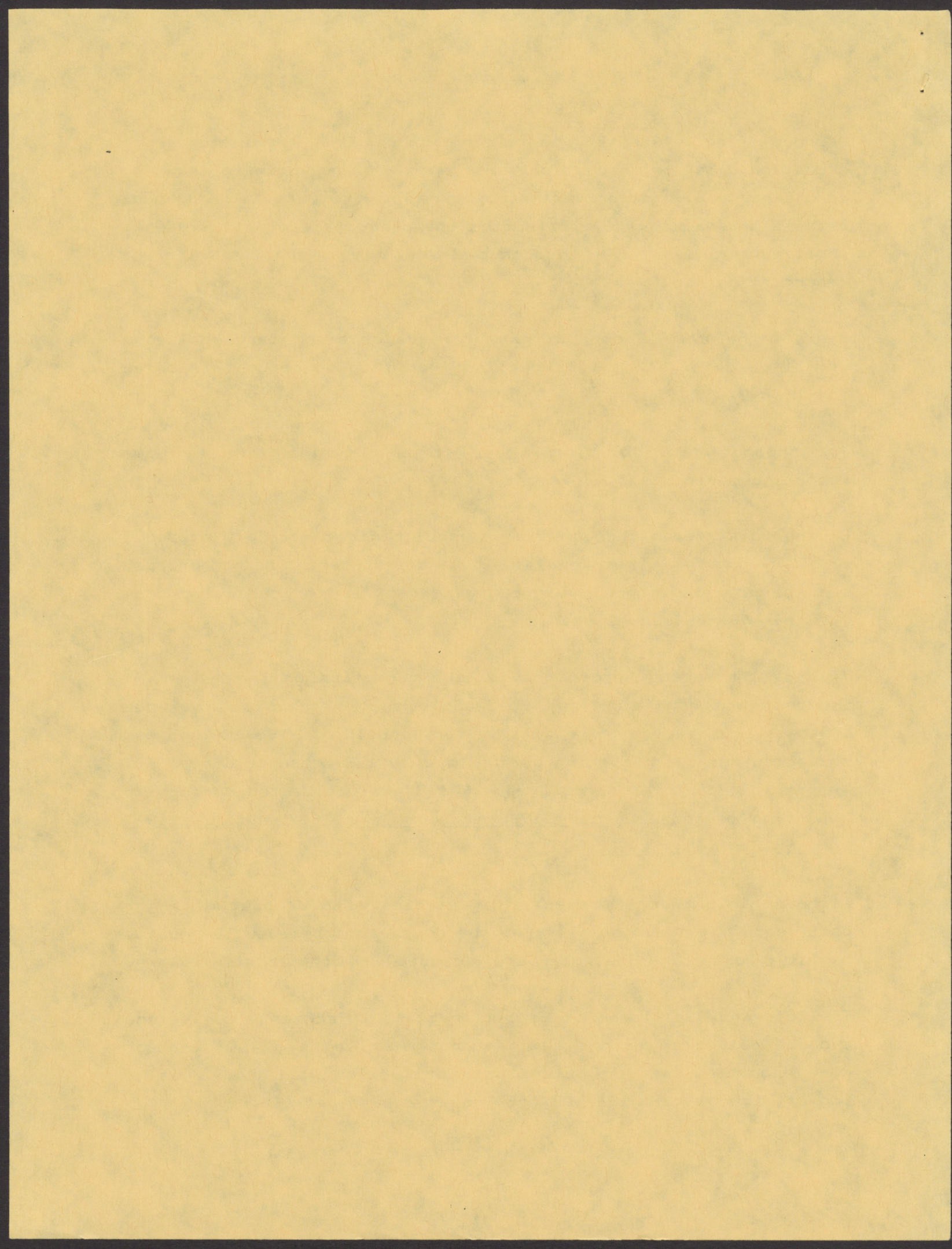

The Hispanic dropout rate declined from 8.1 percent in 1986-87 to 7.5 percent for 1987-88. However, the Hispanic dropout rate remained the highest along with the rate for American Indians at 7.5 percent.

The highest dropout rates for American Indians, Blacks and Hispanics occurred in Grade 10. For Asian and White students the highest dropout rate occurred in grade 11.

Historically, Grade 11 has had the highest overall dropout rate. For 1987-88, both grade 10 and grade 11 have the highest dropout rate at 5.7 percent.

Although the dropout rate for White students was lower than that for the other racial/ethnic groups (except Asians), the number of White student dropouts (6971) accounted for 60.9 percent of all Colorado dropouts in Grades 7-12.

FIGURE 1: BLACK DROPOUT RATES BY GRADE

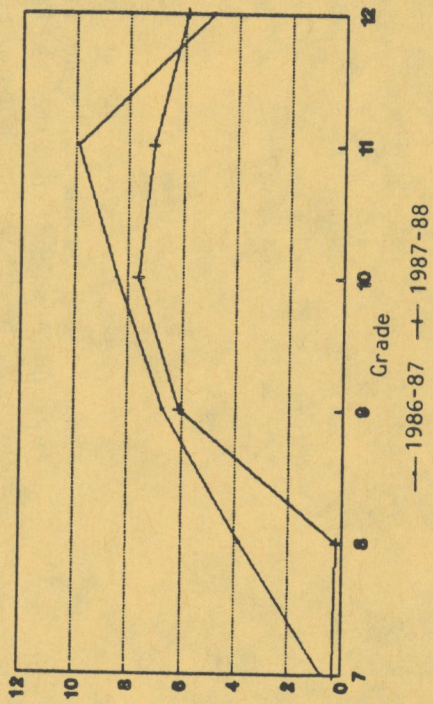


FIGURE 2: HISPANIC DROPOUT RATES BY GRADE

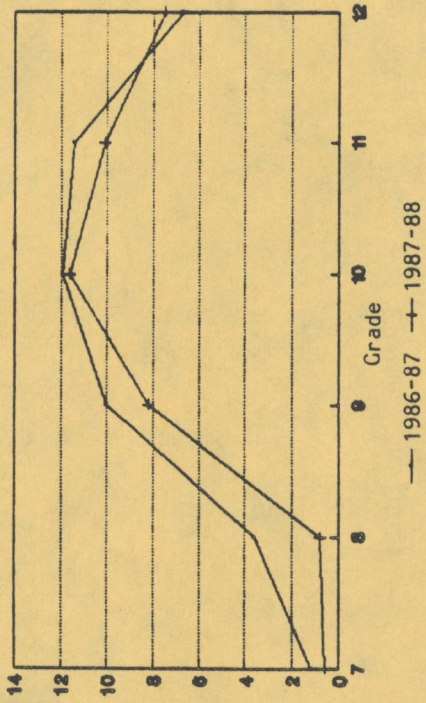


FIGURE 3: WHITE DROPOUT RATES BY GRADE

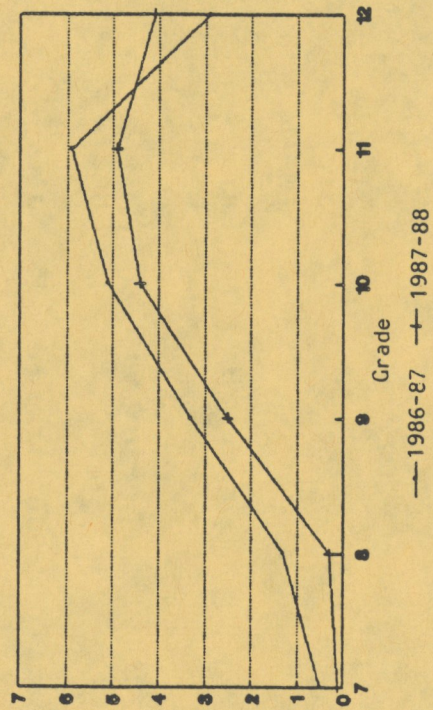


FIGURE 4: TOTAL DROPOUT RATES BY GRADE

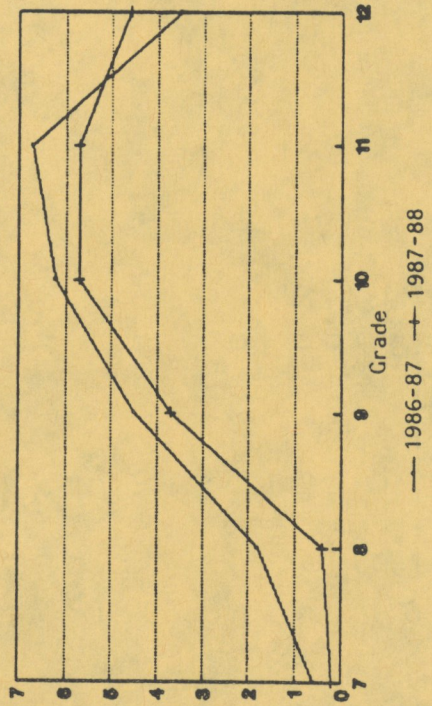

Overall the dropout rates declined for both female and male students. Male students continue to reflect their highest dropout rate in grade 11. However, the highest dropout rate for female students was grade 11 for 1986-87 and changed to grade 10 for 1987-88.
