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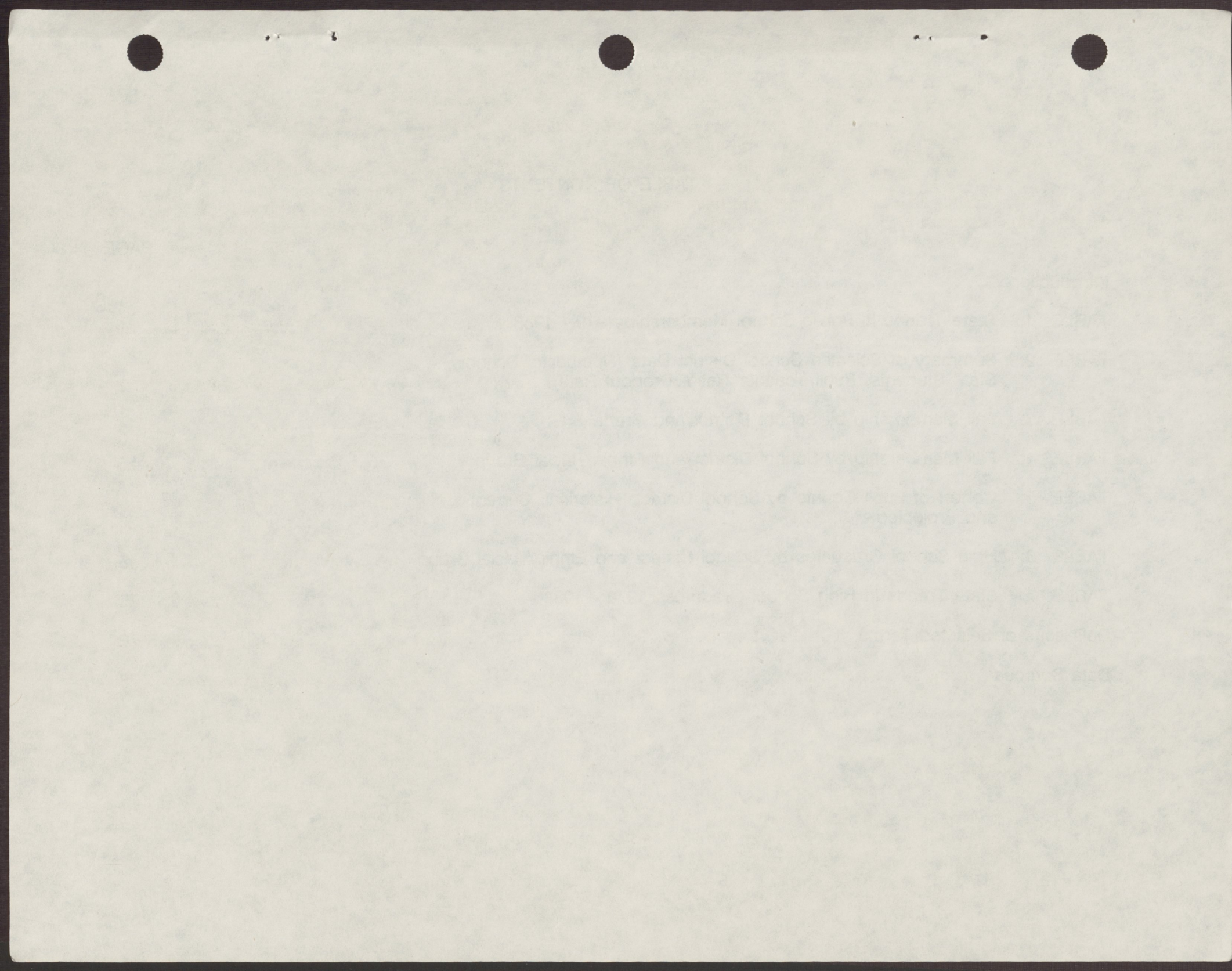

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INTRODUCTION

This report has been prepared from information collected from Colorado's public school districts.

Many of the reports are similar to those we have published in prior years with the exception of the dropout data. The dropout rate included in Table 2 is for grades 10, 11, and 12 only. Additional information is available in a separate publication titled "Report on Colorado Annual Dropout Rates - Grades Seven through Twelve 1987-88."

HIGHLIGHTS:

- . In the fall of 1988 there were 560,081 students enrolled in Colorado's public schools. This represented a slight decrease from the 1987 fall membership of 560,236.
- . Grades two through four reflected the largest increase in student enrollment; 135,588 for fall 1988 over 130,988 for fall 1987, a 3.5 percent increase.
- . Colorado's public school membership declined 4.7 percent between 1975 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend and showing a 3.3 percent increase between 1983 and 1988.
- . Minority student enrollment increased by 15.8 percent between 1978 and 1988 and accounted for 24.0 percent of school membership in 1988.
- . The pupil/teacher ratio in Colorado for fall 1988 was 17.8 to 1. However, when special education and special subject teachers were excluded, the ratio became 23.6 to 1.
- . The 1988 pupil/teacher ratios by type of school indicated a higher ratio for elementary schools (20.0) than for middle schools (17.2), junior high schools (18.6), or senior high schools (17.3).

DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS

The following terms are defined as they generally apply in the text. Some terms are used in more than one table and may include different position categories; therefore, the table in which the term is used follows the definition.

CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Personnel reported working in positions which require state certification.

CLASSROOM TEACHER: A staff member assigned the professional activities of instructing pupils in self-contained classes or courses. This term includes all teachers (Table 2).

DROPOUT: A "dropout" means a person who leaves school for any reason except death before completion of a high school diploma or its equivalent and who does not transfer to another public or private school or enroll in an approved home study program.

DROPOUT RATE: The percentage of the student body in grades 10 through 12 who dropped out during the period July 1987 through June 1988. Additional dropout data is included in a separate publication Report on Colorado Annual Dropout Rates - Grades Seven through Twelve 1987-1988. For a copy contact the Planning and Evaluation Unit, 866-6837.

ETHNIC/RACIAL GROUP: Racial/ethnic designations used in the report do not denote scientific definitions of anthropological origins. For the purpose of this report, a student may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging. However, no person should be counted in more than one racial/ethnic group. This information is required for state and federal reporting.

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine islands and Samoa.

Black, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups.

White, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, the Middle East, or the Indian subcontinent.

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or the Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

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Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or the Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Includes personnel employed in positions which do not require state certification. For example: business managers, directors of transportation, food services, office support, aides, plant operation/maintenance personnel (Table 2).

PUPIL MEMBERSHIP: The pupil count as of the Fall 1988 October One Day Count.

PUPIL/TEACHER RATIO: The number of students in membership as of approximately October 1 divided by the full-time equivalency of teaching assignments serving these students during the same period of time.

SELECTED CLASSROOM TEACHER: This term includes all teachers with the exception of special education teachers, Chapter I, II teachers and teachers in specialized subject areas, such as music, art, physical education, driver education and ROTC (Table 2).

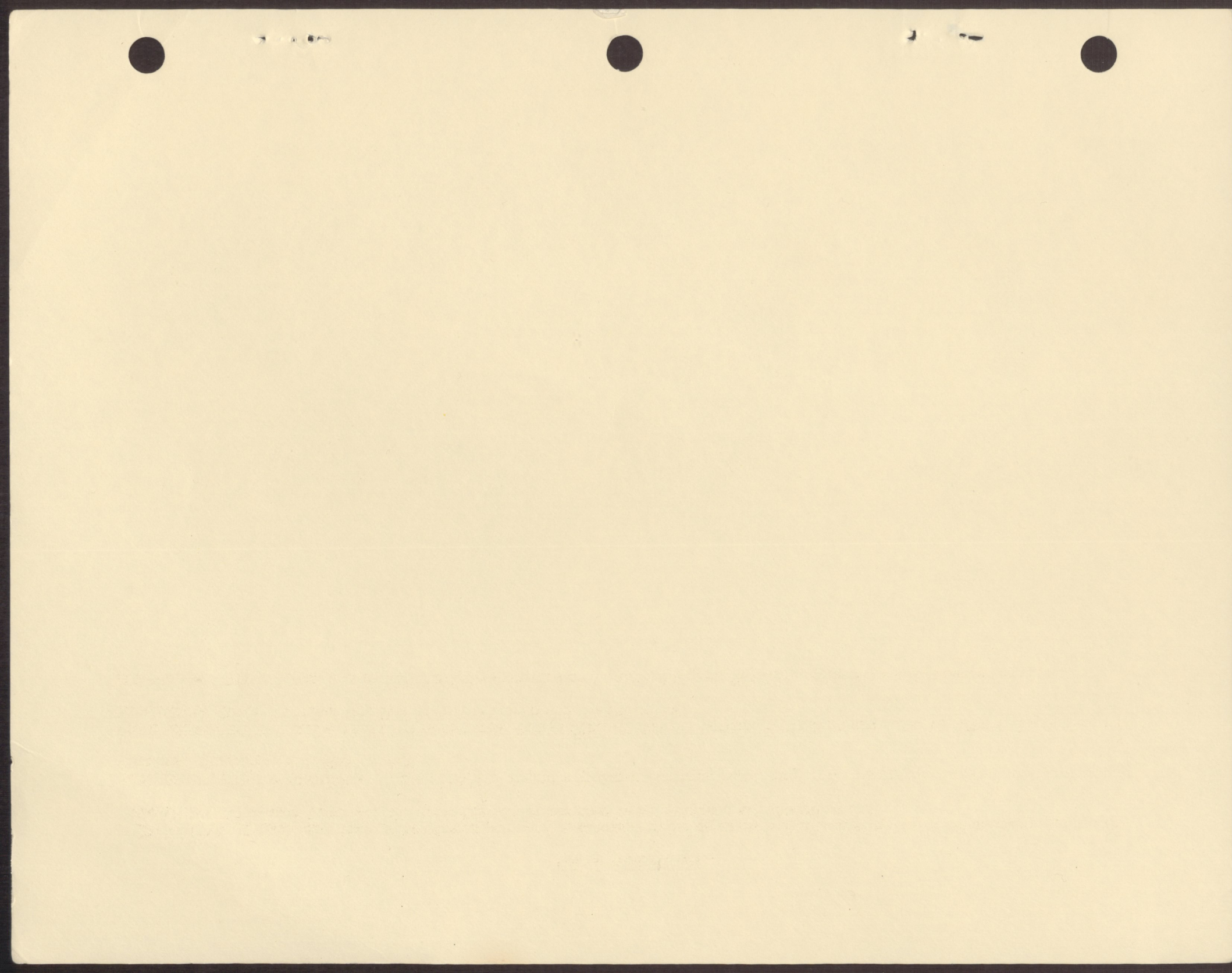
DATA SOURCES

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Part I, Section D - Personnel Employed in Noncertificated Positions. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)

PUPIL MEMBERSHIP: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Part II - Section G Student Membership by School, Grade, Sex, and Racial/Ethnic Group - October One Day Count. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)

DROPOUTS: CDE-2 FORM, End of Year Pupil Membership, Part II - School Report, Dropouts. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)



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
