

INTRODUCTION

This report has been prepared from information collected from Colorado's public school districts.

Many of the pupil membership reports are similar to those we have published in prior years. In addition to providing high school graduates by district, this report includes graduation rates for the Class of 1990. The dropout rate included in Table 2 is for grades 10, 11 and 12 only. Additional information on dropout rates and graduation rates is available in a separate publication titled "Colorado Public School Annual Dropout Rates - Grades Seven Through Twelve 1989-90 and Class of 1990 Graduation Rates."


HIGHLIGHTS:

- In the fall of 1990 there were 574,213 students enrolled in Colorado's public schools, an increase of 11,458 students over the 1989 fall membership of 562,755. This represented the largest increase since 1971 when fall membership increased by 14,422.
- Membership in grades kindergarten through sixth increased 2.9 percent over fall 1989 and 15.7 percent over fall 1981. Grades seven through twelve membership showed a slight increase (.01 percent) over fall 1989, but decreased 6.5 percent from fall 1981.
- Colorado's public school membership declined 4.7 percent between 1975 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. Between 1983 and 1990 fall membership increased by 18.2 percent for minority students, 2.4 percent for white students and 5.9 percent overall.
- Native Americans, Asians, Blacks and Hispanics represented 24.7 percent of the total student population, while these same groups made up 9.2 percent of Colorado's teachers.
- The pupil/teacher ratio in Colorado for fall 1990 was 17.8 to 1. However, when special education and special subject teachers were excluded, the ratio became 23.6 to 1.
- The Denver Metropolitan Area includes 307,847 (53.6 percent) of the total state's pupil membership.

ILLUSTRATION 1:

STATE TRENDS IN FALL MEMBERSHIP FROM 1986 TO 1990



During the period from Fall 1986 to Fall 1990 membership increased by 9.4 percent in grades 1-3, 13.3 percent in grades 4-6 and 1.1 percent in grades 7-9, while grades 10-12 decreased by 11.7 percent.

Should this trend continue, the decade of the nineties will not only show increasing pupil membership in the lower grades but will also show the progression of the elementary increase into the secondary grades.





DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS

The following terms are defined as they generally apply in the text.

CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Personnel reported working in positions which require state certification.

CLASSROOM TEACHER: A staff member assigned the professional activities of instructing pupils in self-contained classes or courses. This term includes all teachers.

COMPLETER RATE: The completer rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who complete an educational program as a percent of those who were in membership. These completers include students who graduate, receive certificates or other designations of high school completion or attendance, or receive a G.E.D. from programs administered by the district.

DROPOUT: A "dropout" means a person who leaves school for any reason except death before completion of a high school diploma or its equivalent and who does not transfer to another public or private school or enroll in an approved home study program.

DROPOUT RATE: The percentage of the student body in grades 10 through 12 who dropped out during the period July 1989 through June 1990. Additional dropout data is included in a separate publication titled "Colorado Public School Annual Dropout Rates - Grades Seven through Twelve 1989-1990 and Class of 1990 Graduation Rates." For a copy contact the Planning and Evaluation Unit, 303/866-6821.

ETHNIC/RACIAL GROUP: Racial/ethnic designations used in the report do not denote scientific definitions of anthropological origins. For the purpose of this report, a student may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging. However, no person should be counted in more than one racial/ethnic group. This information is required for state and federal reporting.

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine islands and Samoa.

Black, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups.

White, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, the Middle East, or the Indian subcontinent.

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or the Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

GRADUATION RATE: The graduation rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who actually graduate as a percent of those who were in membership. The graduation rate for the Class of 1990 is based on a three-year rate, grades 10-12 beginning with the baseline year of data in 1987. Graduation rates are calculated based on high school graduates only. A graduate is a student who completed locally-defined requirements for graduation. If a student is not considered a graduate by the local board of education, then he/she is not included in the graduation rate calculation. (Also see completer rate)

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Includes personnel employed in positions which do not require state certification. For example: business managers, directors of transportation, food services, office support, aides, plant operation/maintenance personnel.

PUPIL MEMBERSHIP: The pupil count as of the Fall 1990 October One Day Count.

PUPIL/TEACHER RATIO: The number of students in membership as of approximately October 1 divided by the full-time equivalency of teaching assignments serving these students during the same period of time.

SELECTED CLASSROOM TEACHER: This term includes all teachers with the exception of special education teachers, Chapter 1 and 2 teachers and teachers in specialized subject areas, such as music, art, physical education, driver education and ROTC.

DATA SOURCES

CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Data on certificated personnel is submitted to the Department of Education by one of the following means, CDE-1 Form/CP-1 Turnaround Document, CP IBM Diskette or Magnetic Tape. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Section D - Personnel Employed in Noncertificated Positions. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)

PUPIL MEMBERSHIP: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Section G Student Membership by School, Grade, Sex, and Racial/Ethnic Group - October One Day Count. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)

DROPOUT RATE, GRADUATION RATE AND GRADUATES: CDE-2 Form, End of Year Pupil Membership Report, High School Graduates and Other Completers, Part II, III and IV. (Planning and Evaluation Unit)
