

INTRODUCTION

This report has been prepared from information collected from Colorado's public school districts.

Many student membership reports contained in this publication are similar to those we have published in prior years. In addition to providing high school graduates by district, this report includes graduation rates for the Class of 1991. The dropout rate included in Table 2 is for grades 10, 11 and 12 only. Additional information on dropout rates and graduation rates is available in a separate publication titled Colorado Public School Annual Dropout Rates - Grades Seven Through Twelve 1990-91 and Class of 1991 Graduation Rates.


HIGHLIGHTS:


- In the fall of 1991 there were 593,030 students in Colorado's public schools. This is the second consecutive year Colorado's membership has shown a substantial increase from the previous year. The fall 1990 membership increased by 11,458 students (2.0%) and the fall 1991 membership increased by 18,817 students (3.3%).
- The fall 1991 membership was the largest in Colorado's history, surpassing the previous membership peak in 1972. Colorado's public school membership declined 5.6 percent between 1972 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. Between 1983 and 1991 fall membership increased by 23.8 percent for minority students, 5.3 percent for white students and 9.4 percent overall.
- Native Americans, Asians, Blacks and Hispanics represented 25.1 percent of the total student population, while these same groups made up 9.3 percent of Colorado's teachers.
- Fall 1991 membership in elementary grades increased 3.7 percent over fall 1990 and 21.6 percent over fall 1983. However, membership in secondary grades decreased 4.2 percent from fall 1983 and increased 2.6 percent over fall 1990.
- The pupil/teacher ratio in Colorado for fall 1991 was 17.9 to 1. However, when special education and special subject teachers were excluded, the ratio became 23.9 to 1.
- The Denver Metropolitan Area includes 319,385 (53.9 percent) of the total state's student membership. Colorado's ten largest school districts, with student membership over 17,000, account for 327,064 (55.2%) of the state's total student membership.
- The graduation rate for Class of 1991 was 78.9 percent. The decline of 1.1 percentage points from the 1990 graduation rate of 80.0 percent is a result of the 1990 rate being based on a 3-year rate encompassing grade 10-12. The Class of 1991 graduation rate is based on a 4-year rate. A 3-year recalculation for the Class of 1991 produced an 80.5 percent graduation rate.

ILLUSTRATION 1: STATE TRENDS IN FALL MEMBERSHIP FROM FALL 1972 TO FALL 1991






- The fall 1991 student membership surpassed the previous membership peak in fall 1972. Colorado's public school membership declined 5.6 percent between 1972 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. Between 1983 and 1991 fall membership increased 9.4 percent overall.
- Elementary grades also showed an upward trend beginning in fall 1983. From fall 1972 to fall 1991 elementary grades reflected a 13.4
 percent increase.
- Membership in secondary grades declined overall 11.0 percent from fall 1972 to fall 1989 with a slight rise in 1975 and 1976. From fall 1989 to fall 1991 secondary grade membership has shown a slight increase.

During the period from fall 1986 to fall 1991 membership increased by 11.7 percent in grades 1-3, 19.0 percent in grades 4-6 and 5.7 percent in grades 7-9, while grades 10-12 decreased by 10.2 percent. The current trend not only indicates increasing student membership in the lower grades but also the progression of the elementary increase into the secondary grades.

- The graduation rate for Class of 1991 was 78.9 percent. This was a decline of 1.1 percentage points from the 1990 graduation rate of 80.0 percent. This decline was a result of the 1990 rate being based on a 3-year rate encompassing grade 10-12. The Class of 1991 graduation rate was based on a 4-year rate. A 3-year recalculation for the Class of 1991 produced an 80.5 percent graduation rate.
- The graduation rate for regular high school programs (excluding alternative) was 81.4 percent.
- Female students (81.2 percent) reflected a higher graduation rate than male students (76.8 percent).
- The completer rate (79.8 percent) includes graduates and students who receive another certificate or designation of high school completion. The completer rate was 0.9 percentage points higher than the graduation rate.

DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS

The following terms are defined as they apply in the text.

CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Personnel reported working in positions which require state certification.

CLASSROOM TEACHER: A staff member assigned the professional activities of instructing pupils in self-contained classes or courses. This term includes all teachers.

COMPLETER RATE: The completer rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who complete an educational program as a percent of those who were in membership. These completers include students who graduate, receive certificates or other designations of high school completion or attendance, or receive a G.E.D. from programs administered by the district.

DROPOUT: A dropout is a person who leaves school for any reason except death before completion of a high school diploma or its equivalent and who does not transfer to another public or private school or enroll in an approved home study program.

DROPOUT RATE: The dropout rate used in Table 2 is the percentage of the student body in grades 10 through 12 who dropped out during the period July 1990 through June 1991. Additional dropout data is included in a separate publication titled <u>Colorado Public School Annual Dropout Rates - Grades Seven through Twelve 1990-1991 and Class of 1991 Graduation Rates.</u> For a copy contact the Planning and Evaluation Unit, 303/866-6821.

ETHNIC/RACIAL GROUP: Ethnic/racial designations used in the report do not denote scientific definitions of anthropological origins. For the purpose of this report, a student may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging. However, no person should be counted in more than one ethnic/racial group. This information is required for state and federal reporting.

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands and Samoa.

Black, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups.

White, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, the Middle East, or the Indian subcontinent.

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or the Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

GRADUATION RATE: The graduation rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who actually graduate as a percent of those who were in membership. The graduation rate for the Class of 1991 is based on a 4-year rate, grades 9-12 beginning with the baseline year of data in 1987. Graduation rates are calculated based on high school graduates only. A graduate is a student who completed locally-defined requirements for graduation. If a student is not considered a graduate by the local board of education, then he/she is not included in the graduation rate calculation. (Also see completer rate.)

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Includes personnel employed in positions which do not require state certification. For example: business managers, directors of transportation, food services, office support, aides, plant operation/maintenance personnel.

PUPIL MEMBERSHIP: The pupil count as of the Fall 1991 October One Day Count.

PUPIL/TEACHER RATIO: The number of students in membership as of approximately October 1 divided by the full-time equivalency of teaching assignments serving these students during the same period of time.
