

INTRODUCTION

Information used to prepare this publication was collected from Colorado's public school districts.

Many student membership tables contained in this publication are similar to those published in prior years. The dropout rate included in Table 2 is for grades 10-12 only. Additional information on dropout and graduation rates is available in a separate publication titled Colorado Graduation Rates for Class of 1995 and 1994-95 Annual Dropout Rates for Grades 7-12.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- In fall 1995, there were 656,279 students in Colorado's public schools, an increase of 15,758 students (2.5%) over the fall 1994 membership of 640,521. Fall membership grew by 64,632 students (10.6%) from fall 1991 to fall 1995.
- Beginning with fall 1990, membership each year has surpassed the previous membership peak of 1972. Colorado's public school membership declined 5.6 percent between 1972 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. From fall 1984 to fall 1995 student membership increased by 110,852 students (20.3%).
- Membership continues to rise in both elementary and secondary grades. Fall 1995 public school membership in elementary grades increased by 6,113 students (1.6%) over fall 1994 and by 26,822 students (7.7%) over fall 1991. In secondary grades public school membership increased by 9,645 students (3.5%) over fall 1994 and 36,427 students (14.8%) over fall 1991. For the sixth consecutive year, Colorado's student membership has shown a substantial increase from the previous year.
- Between 1991 and 1995 fall membership in public schools increased by 31,542 (21.2%) for minority students and 31,707 (7.1%) for white students. Native Americans, Asians, Blacks and Hispanics represented 27.5 percent of the fall 1995 student membership, while these same groups made up 9.0 percent of Colorado's teachers.
- The ten largest school districts in 1995 increased their membership by 9,053 students (2.6%) over fall 1994 and 31,090 students (9.5%) over fall 1991. Colorado's ten largest public school districts account for 358,154 (54.5%) of the total student membership in fall 1995. Of the total increase from fall 1991 to fall 1995, the ten largest school districts in 1995 account for 49.1 percent of that growth.
- The Denver Metropolitan Area includes 351,621 (53.5%) of the state's total student membership in public schools.
- The fall 1995 pupil/teacher ratio of 18.5 to 1 increased from 18.4 to 1 in fall 1994. When special education and special subject teachers are excluded the ratio was 24.7 to 1 in fall 1995.
- Colorado's graduation rate for Class of 1995 was 77.4 percent. This is a decrease of 1.4 percentage points from rates reported for Class of 1994. The 1995 graduation rate is a four-year rate based on students reported by school districts beginning 9th grade in the 1991-92 school year.





- From fall 1985 to fall 1995 Colorado's public school membership increased by 105,637 students (19.1%). Colorado's ten largest school districts in 1995 increased their membership by 49,153 students (15.9%) during that same period. The ten largest districts account for 358,181 (54.5%) of the state's total fall 1995 public school membership.
- The Denver/Metro area includes 351,621 (53.5%) of the state's total fall 1995 student membership in public schools. From fall 1985 to fall 1995, student membership in the Denver/Metro area increased by 54,160 students (18.2%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 51,477 students (20.3%).

ILLUSTRATION 2 STATE TRENDS IN STUDENT MEMBERSHIP FROM FALL 1972 TO FALL 1995





- Colorado's public school membership declined 5.6 percent between 1972 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. Student membership
 for the last four years surpassed the previous membership peak in fall 1972. Between 1983 and 1995 fall membership increased 21.0 percent
 overall.
- Elementary grades reflected a 6.7 percent decline from fall 1972 to fall 1983. Beginning fall 1983 elementary grades experienced a large increase in membership. From fall 1983 to fall 1995 student population in elementary grades increased by 89,272 students (31.2%). The fall 1995 student membership in elementary grades increased by 6,113 students from fall 1994.
- Membership in secondary grades declined overall 11.7 percent from fall 1972 to fall 1989 with a slight rise between 1973 and 1976. From fall 1989 to fall 1995 secondary grade membership has shown a 19.8 percent increase. Student membership for secondary grades in fall 1995 increased by 9,645 students over the fall 1994 membership and was the largest since fall 1977.

DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS

The following terms are defined as they apply in the text.

CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Personnel reported working in positions which require state certification.

<u>CLASSROOM TEACHER</u>: A staff member assigned the professional activities of instructing pupils in self-contained classes or courses. This term includes all teachers.

<u>COMPLETER RATE</u>: The completer rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who complete an educational program as a percent of those who were in membership. Completers include students who graduate, receive certificates or other designations of high school completion or attendance, or receive a G.E.D. (General Education Development Certificate) from programs administered by the school district.

<u>DROPOUT</u>: A dropout is a person who leaves school for any reason except death before completion of a high school diploma or its equivalent and who does not transfer to another public or private school or enroll in an approved home study program.

<u>DROPOUT RATE</u>: The dropout rate used in Table 2 represents the percentage of students in grades 10 through 12 who dropped out during the period July 1994 through June 1995. In accordance with a 1993 legislative mandate, beginning with the 1993-94 school year, the dropout rate calculation excludes expelled students. Additional information on dropout and graduation rates is available in a separate publication titled <u>Colorado Graduation Rates for Class of 1995 and 1994-95 Annual Dropout Rates for Grades 7-12.</u> For a copy of this report contact the Research and Evaluation Unit, 303/866-6821.

ETHNIC/RACIAL GROUP: Ethnic/racial designations used in this report do not denote scientific definitions of anthropological origins. For the purpose of this report, a student may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging. However, no person should be counted in more than one ethnic/racial group. This information is required for state and federal reporting.

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands and Samoa.

Black, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups.

White, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, the Middle East, or the Indian subcontinent.

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or the Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS (Continued)

GRADUATION RATE: The graduation rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who actually graduate as a percentage of those who were in membership. The graduation rate for the Class of 1995 is based on a four-year rate, grades 9-12 beginning with the baseline year of data in 1991. Graduation rates are calculated based on high school graduates only. A graduate is a student who completes locally-defined requirements for graduation. If a student is not considered a graduate by the local board of education, then he/she is not included in the graduation rate calculation. (Also see completer rate.)

HOME STUDY PUPIL COUNT: The count of pupils receiving instruction under an established system of a home study program as of October 1.

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: Includes personnel employed in positions which do not require state certification. For example: business managers, directors of transportation, food services, office support, aides, plant operation/maintenance personnel.

NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP: The pupil count reported in membership as of October 1, 1995 in Colorado's private, parochial and independent schools which provide education to children from kindergarten to grade 12.

PUBLIC SCHOOL PUPIL MEMBERSHIP: The pupil count reported in membership in Colorado's public schools as of the Fall 1995 October One Day Count.

<u>PUPIL/TEACHER RATIO</u>: The number of students in membership in public schools divided by the full-time equivalency of classroom teaching assignments serving these students as of fall 1995.

<u>SELECTED CLASSROOM TEACHER</u>: This term includes all teachers with the exception of special education teachers, Chapters 1 and 2 teachers and teachers in specialized subject areas such as music, art, physical education, driver education and ROTC.

DATA SOURCES

<u>CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL</u>: Data on certificated personnel is submitted to the Department of Education by one of the following means, CDE-1 Form/CP-1 Turnaround Document, CP IBM Diskette or Magnetic Tape. (Research and Evaluation Unit)

HOME STUDY PUPIL COUNT: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Section C2 - Home Study Pupil Count as of October 1. (Research and Evaluation Unit)

NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Section D - Personnel Employed in Noncertificated Positions. (Research and Evaluation Unit)

NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Section C1 - Non-Public School Information as of October 1. (Research and Evaluation Unit)

<u>PUBLIC SCHOOL PUPIL MEMBERSHIP</u>: CDE-4 Form, Fall Report from School Districts, Section G - Student Membership by School, Grade, Sex, and Ethnic/Racial Group - October One Day Count. (Research and Evaluation Unit)

<u>DROPOUT RATE, GRADUATION RATE AND GRADUATES</u>: CDE-2 Form, Part II - End of Year Pupil Membership and Dropout Data Collection, Part III and IV - Spring and Summer High School Graduates and Other Completers, and Part V - Membership Base Adjustment for Graduation Rate Process. (Research and Evaluation Unit)
