

INTRODUCTION

Information used to prepare this publication was collected from Colorado's public school districts.

Many student membership tables contained in this publication are similar to those published in prior years. The dropout rate included in Table 2 is for grades 10-12 only. Additional information on dropout and graduation rates is available in a separate publication titled Colorado Graduation Rates for Class of 1997 and 1996-97 Annual Dropout Rates for Grades 7-12.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- In fall 1997, there were 687,167 students in Colorado's public schools, an increase of 13,729 students (2.0%) over the fall 1996 membership of 673,438. Fall membership grew by 62,105 students (9.9%) from fall 1993 to fall 1997.
- Beginning with fall 1990, membership each year has surpassed the previous membership peak of 1972. Colorado's public school membership declined 5.6 percent between 1972 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. From fall 1984 to fall 1997 student membership increased by 141,740 students (26.0%).
- Membership continues to rise in both elementary and secondary grades. Fall 1997 public school membership in elementary grades increased by 5,873 students (1.5%) over fall 1996 and by 30,216 students (8.4%) over fall 1992. In secondary grades public school membership increased by 7,856 students (2.7%) over fall 1996 and 44,316 students (17.4%) over fall 1992. For the seventh consecutive year, Colorado's student membership has shown a substantial increase from the previous year.
- Between 1993 and 1997 fall membership in public schools increased by 35,117 (21.7%) for minority students and 26,988 (5.8%) for white students.
 Native Americans, Asians, Blacks and Hispanics represented 28.7 percent of the fall 1997 student membership, while these same groups made up 9.2 percent of Colorado's teachers.
- The ten largest school districts in 1997 increased their membership by 9,395 students (2.5%) over fall 1996 and 40,447 students (12.0%) over fall 1992. Colorado's ten largest public school districts account for 377,909 (55.0%) of the total student membership in fall 1997. Of the total increase from fall 1992 to fall 1997, the ten largest school districts in 1997 account for 54.3 percent of that growth.
- The Denver Metropolitan Area includes 371,327 (54.0%) of the state's total student membership in public schools.
- The fall 1997 pupil/teacher ratio of 18.2 decreased 0.3 percentage points from fall 1996. When special education and special subject teachers are excluded the ratio was 24.0 to 1 in fall 1997.
- Colorado's graduation rate for Class of 1997 was 78.5 percent. This is an increase of 0.8 percentage points from rates reported for Class of 1996. The 1997 graduation rate is a four-year rate based on students reported by school districts beginning 9th grade in the 1993-94 school year.





- From fall 1987 to fall 1997 Colorado's public school membership increased by 126,931 students (22.7%). Colorado's ten largest school districts in 1997 increased their membership by 66,352 students (21.3%) during that same period. The ten largest districts account for 377,909 (55.0%) of the state's total fall 1997 public school membership.
- The Denver/Metro area includes 371,327 (54.0%) of the state's total fall 1997 student membership in public schools. From fall 1987 to fall 1997, student membership in the Denver/Metro area increased by 70,260 students (23.3%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 56,671 students (21.9%).





- Colorado's public school membership declined 5.6 percent between 1972 and 1983 before beginning an upward trend. Student membership since 1991 has consistently surpassed the previous membership peak in fall 1972. Between 1983 and 1997 fall membership increased 26.7 percent overall.
- Elementary grades reflected a 6.7 percent decline from fall 1972 to fall 1983. Beginning fall 1983 elementary grades experienced a large increase in membership. From fall 1983 to fall 1997 student population in elementary grades increased by 102,471 students (35.9%). The fall 1997 student membership in elementary grades increased by 5,873 students from fall 1996.
- Membership in secondary grades declined overall 11.7 percent from fall 1972 to fall 1989 with a slight rise between 1973 and 1976. From fall 1989 to fall 1997 secondary grade membership has shown a 19.1 percent increase. Student membership for secondary grades in fall 1997 increased by 7,856 students over the fall 1996 membership.

DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS

The following terms are defined as they apply in the text.

<u>CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL:</u> Personnel reported working in positions which require state certification.

<u>CLASSROOM TEACHER:</u> A staff member assigned the professional activities of instructing pupils in self-contained classes or courses. This term includes all teachers.

<u>COMPLETER RATE</u>: The completer rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who complete an educational program as a percent of those who were in membership. Completers include students who graduate, receive certificates or other designations of high school completion or attendance, or receive a G.E.D. (General Education Development Certificate) from programs administered by the school district.

<u>DROPOUT</u>: A dropout is a person who leaves school for any reason except death before completion of a high school diploma or its equivalent and who does not transfer to another public or private school or enroll in an approved home study program.

DROPOUT RATE: The dropout rate used in Table 2 represents the percentage of students in grades 10 through 12 who dropped out during the period July 1995 through June 1996. In accordance with a 1993 legislative mandate, beginning with the 1993-94 school year, the dropout rate calculation excludes expelled students. Additional information on dropout and graduation rates is available in a separate publication titled Colorado Graduation Rates for Class of 1996 and 1995-96 Annual Dropout Rates for Grades 7-12. ETHNIC/RACIAL GROUP: Ethnic/racial designations used in this report do not denote scientific definitions of anthropological origins. For the purpose of this report, a student may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging. However, no person should be counted in more than one ethnic/racial group. This information is required for state and federal reporting.

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands and Samoa.

Black, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups.

White, Not of Hispanic Origin - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, the Middle East, or the Indian subcontinent.

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or the Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

DEFINITIONS OF SELECTED TERMS (Continued)

GRADUATION RATE: The graduation rate is a cumulative or longitudinal rate which calculates the number of students who actually graduate as a percentage of those who were in membership. The graduation rate for the Class of 1996 is based on a four-year rate, grades 9-12 beginning with the baseline year of data in 1992. Graduation rates are calculated based on high school graduates only. A graduate is a student who completes locally-defined requirements for graduation. If a student is not considered a graduate by the local board of education, then he/she is not included in the graduation rate calculation. (Also see completer rate.)

HOME STUDY PUPIL COUNT: The count of pupils receiving instruction under an established system of a home study program as of October 1.

<u>NONCERTIFICATED PERSONNEL:</u> Includes personnel employed in positions which do not require state certification. For example: business managers, directors of transportation, food services, office support, aides, plant operation/maintenance personnel.

NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP: The pupil count reported in membership as of October 1, 1996 in Colorado's private, parochial and independent schools which provide education to children from kindergarten to grade 12.

<u>PUBLIC SCHOOL PUPIL MEMBERSHIP:</u> The pupil count reported in membership in Colorado's public schools as of the Fall 1996 October One Day Count.

<u>PUPIL/TEACHER RATIO</u>: The number of students in membership in public schools divided by the full-time equivalency of classroom teaching assignments serving these students as of fall 1996.

<u>SELECTED CLASSROOM TEACHER:</u> This term includes all teachers with the exception of special education teachers, Titles 1 and 6 teachers and teachers in specialized subject areas such as music, art, physical education, driver education and ROTC.

DATA SOURCES

<u>CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL:</u> Data on certificated personnel is submitted to the Department of Education by one of the following means, CDE-1 Form/CP-1 Turnaround Document, CP IBM Diskette or Magnetic Tape. (Research and Evaluation Unit)


