Flash Technology Explains Technology in Techtionary

If you are interested in telecommunications and networking and would like more than a general definition of terms, check out <u>Techtionary</u>. This is an online dictionary that uses flash technology to provide diagrams and pictures explaining complex terms such as ATM, Ethernet, and fiber optic cable along with functions. This seems to be a relatively new site, but coverage of terms appears to be growing. For the terms it does describe, the animation and diagrams provide a much richer understanding than just plain text, advises the CSL technical consultant.

Visual Arts Videos and Classic Cinema DVDs Offered

Two curated collections, "The Visual Arts" and "Cinema Classics on DVD," are the newest collections with discount consortiums from the non-profit Library Media Project, which evolved from the MacArthur Foundation Library Video Project. "Cinema Classics on DVD" combines a selection curated by Roger Ebert with a special public library discount. It includes some of the best movies from the silent era; foreign films from France, Japan, Italy, Sweden, Russia; classic American dramas; significant documentaries; and comedies.

It offers a rich texture of diverse artists and art genres and of art histories and cultures at special discount consortium prices.
