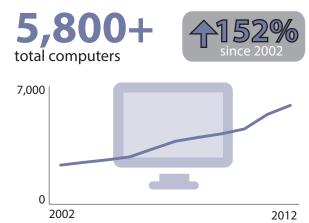
## **Computers in Colorado's Public Libraries**

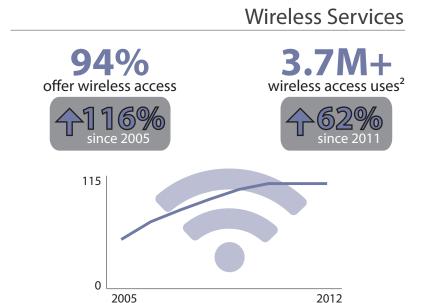
Internet Computers for Public Use
