Statewide, grades PK, K and 6 showed the highest increases in fall 2001 membership from fall 2000. Within the 2001 collection, districts reported the pre-kindergarten students they were serving although funding was not necessarily attached.

Counts of ungraded students have decreased over the last 20 years because all pupils (including special education) are now reported within grade level.
