The percentage change of pupil membership by Racial/Ethnic group from fall 1991 to fall 2001 shows Hispanic students reflecting the largest increase of 6.7 percentage points (16.6 to 23.3), followed by Asian at 0.7, Black at 0.5 and American Indian at 0.2 percentage points. Pupil membership for White students decreased by 8.1 percentage points during the same 11-year period.

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
