The percentage change of pupil membership by Racial/Ethnic group from fall 1991 to fall 2001 shows Hispanic students reflecting the largest increase of 6.7 percentage points ( 16.6 to 23.3 ), followed by Asian at 0.7 , Black at 0.5 and American Indian at 0.2 percentage points. Pupil membership for White students decreased by 8.1 percentage points during the same 11 -year period.
