

DENVER METRO AREA STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

The Denver Metro Area includes 414,174 (55.1%) of the state's total Fall 2002 student membership (751,862) in public schools. From Fall 1992 to Fall 2002 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 83,926 students (25.4%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 55,301 students (19.6%).
