Statewide, grades PK, 7 and 12 showed the highest increases in fall 2002 membership from fall 2001. The 2002 pre-kindergarten student counts include counts of students that may not have been previously reported. The 2002 counts reflect Colorado Preschool Program, Special Education, tuitioned and non-funded pre-kindergarten students.

Counts of ungraded students have decreased over the last 20 years because all pupils (including special education) are now reported within grade level.
