The Denver Metro Area includes 444,205 (55.34%) of the state's total Fall 2007 student membership (802,639) in public schools. From Fall 1997 to Fall 2007 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 72,878 students (19.63%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 42,594 students (13.49%).

\* NOTE: Detention Center students were removed from the district count and pulled into a separate category. Although detention center students receive educational services from school district employees, school districts have no jurisdiction over any other detention center function.
