The Denver Metro Area includes 457,962 (55.96 %) of the state's total Fall 2008 student membership (818,443) in public schools. From Fall 1998 to Fall 2008 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 77,729 students (20.44%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 41,579 students (13.04%).

* NOTE: Detention Center students were removed from the district count and pulled into a separate category. Although detention center students receive educational services from school district employees, school districts have no jurisdiction over any other detention center function.
