## SENATE JOURNAL.

### FIRST DAY

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 6, 1897.

The Senate of the Eleventh General Assembly of Colorado convened, according to law, at 12 o'clock, noon. Lieutenant Governor Brush called to order. A. B. Gray, Secretary of the previous session, acting as Temporary Secretary. Prayer by the Rev. Myron W. Reed.

Lieutenant Governor Brush addressed the Senate as follows:

Senators: Allow me to congratulate you upon the happy auspices under which we meet. No assembly heretofore has been as well provided with a Senate chamber and with all the necessary conveniences for carrying on your work as this.

I congratulate the "holdover Senators" that they are all, with the exception of three, now present and in good health. Death has called two of our Senators from active life since our adjournment: Our worthy President pro tem., Senator Pease, and our big-hearted, generous Senator Fulton.

I am sorry to announce the ill health of Senator Bolsinger, who is not with us, and may not be able, during the present session of the Senate, to be with us.
