DESIGNATION OF THE COLORADO STATE 1202 COMMISSION AS THE STATE PLANNING AGENCY FOR EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION CENTERS

- WHEREAS, program authority for certain federally-assisted state programs conducted under provisions of the Higher Education Act of 1965, has been assigned to the Colorado State 1202 Commission; and
- WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has now included in its appropriations funds for state planning of Educational Information Centers, contigent upon state designation of an appropriate planning agency for such Centers; and
- WHEREAS, the staff of the Commission has for some time been involved in the planning of such centers for Colorado, and is in a position to maximize the planning activities therefor which are taking place in the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby:

1. Designate the Colorado State 1202 Commission as the state planning agency for Educational Information Centers in Colorado;

2. Authorized the Staff Director of the Commission to apply for and receive such Federal Funds as may be authorized for use by the State of Colorado in planning for such centers, and to use and allocate such funds in accordance with the regulations applicable thereto.
