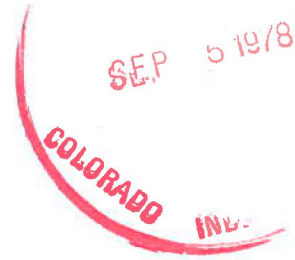

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON PUBLIC BROADCASTING

WHEREAS, public broadcasting is an important element of Colorado's educational system; and

WHEREAS, statewide coordination is necessary to the efficient operation and promotion of public broadcasting in Colorado;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby order and direct that:

1. There be hereby created a Governor's Commission on Public Broadcasting, hereinafter referred to as the Commission.
2. The Commission shall receive support services from the Office of State Planning and Budgeting.
3. The Commission shall consist of not more than 15 members appointed by the Governor.
4. The Governor shall select a Chairperson from among the members.
5. The terms of appointment shall be for one year.
6. The purpose of the Commission shall be to:
  - A. Review the present state of public broadcasting in the State of Colorado, including
    - (1.) a review of the previous studies and plans dealing with public broadcasting, and
    - (2.) meeting with representatives of public broadcasting stations and licensees and drawing upon them for relevant information and data;
  - B. Develop, revise and coordinate implementation of a statewide plan for public broadcasting;

- C. Render advice to the various State agencies concerned with public broadcasting; and
- D. Make recommendations to the Governor, the General Assembly and other State officials and agencies with respect to State and Federal funding for public broadcasting.
