EXECUTIVE ORDER

SOLAR ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO THE COLORADO OFFICE OF ENERGY CONSERVATION

WHEREAS, the Colorado Solar Action Plan and the Western Regional Solar Utilization Network Plan specify that Colorado shall establish a solar advisory committee to provide expert and technical advice to the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation; and

WHEREAS, the decentralized and diverse nature of solar energy technologies makes it necessary to involve a broad-based cross-section of private sector expertise in effective solar energy commercialization planning;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby order and direct that effective immediately:

1. The Solar Advisory Committee to the Office of Energy Conservation be established.
2. The chairperson of the Committee shall be the appointed Colorado representative to the Board of Directors of the Western Solar Utilization Network.
3. The Governor shall appoint no more than 25 members to serve two-year terms, except that the terms of those first appointed shall be staggered (half of the members appointed for one year and half of the members appointed for two years). Members may be reappointed at the Governor's discretion.
4. The members shall be representative of diverse geographic regions in the State, diverse expertise areas in solar technologies including wind and bio-fuels, and diverse professional affiliations, interests, income levels and backgrounds.
