EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO MAPPING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the second session of the Forty-ninth General Assembly has authorized the Division of Planning, Department of Affairs, to enter into a cooperative mapping agreement with the Geological Survey, U. S. Department of the Interior, and to contract for statewide aerial photographic coverage; and

WHEREAS, several State, county and local agencies and regional organizations are users of cartographic and aerial photographic resources; and

WHEREAS, there is a requirement for cartographic standards and specifications for these State, county and local agencies and regional organizations; and

WHEREAS, there is a requirement for the standardization of Colorado geographic place and feature names; and

WHEREAS, an advisory committee would provide appropriate coordination among interested groups and governmental agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby establish a Colorado Mapping Advisory Committee:

- A. The Committee would have the following responsibilities:
 - 1. Provide advice and counsel on cartographic matters to the State Cartographer who shall serve as chairman of the Committee;
