EXECUTIVE ORDER

THE ASSIGNMENT OF CARTOGRAPHIC RESPONSIBILITIES

WHEREAS, the second session of the Forty-ninth General Assembly has authorized the Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs, to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Geological Survey, U. S. Department of the Interior, and to contract for statewide aerial photographic coverage; and

WHEREAS, several State, county and local agencies and regional organizations are users of cartographic and aerial photographic resources; and

WHEREAS, there is a requirement for cartographic standards and specifications for these State, county and local agencies and regional organizations, and

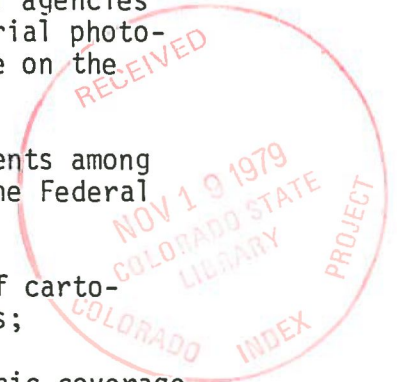
WHEREAS, there is a requirement for the standardization of Colorado geographic place and feature names; and

WHEREAS, the State Cartographer has been assigned to the Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs; and is the Chairman of the Colorado Mapping Advisory Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby direct:


The Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs, shall be responsible for the following cartographic and related duties:

1. Consult, advise and assist State, county and local agencies and regional organizations on cartographic and aerial photographic resources and provide technical assistance on the utilization of these resources;
2. Coordinate and monitor cooperative mapping agreements among government agencies and provide liaison between the Federal and State mapping communities;
3. Provide official base maps and maintain indexes of cartographic, aerial photographic and related resources;
4. Provide statewide, high-altitude aerial photographic coverage and coordinate aerial photographic projects;



5. Coordinate high-altitude remote sensor projects;
6. Develop and maintain standards and criteria for the cartographic display of automated mapping and geocoding systems;
7. Coordinate the preparation of budgets for all State cartographic needs; and
8. Coordinate the standardization of Colorado geographic place and feature names on cartographic resources and in other official publications and provide liaison with the U. S. Board on Geographic Names.
