- the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended WHEREAS, in 1980 by the 96th Congress, 2nd session, has been enacted to identify, register, and preserve important cultural properties significant to the nation's heritage; and
- WHEREAS, the Act, as amended, authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to expand and maintain a National Register of Historic Places composed of districts, sites, buildings, structures, and objects significant in American history, architecture, archaeology, engineering, and culture; and
- WHEREAS, the Act, as amended, provides for the designation and appointment of a State Historic Preservation Officer to nominate properties to the National Register of Historic Places and to administer a State historic preservation program; and
- WHEREAS, the Act, as amended, provides for the appointment of an adequate and qualified State historic preservation review board to assist the State Historic Preservation Officer in the execution of his or her duties and responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado and the National Historic Preservation Act do hereby create the Historic Preservation State Review Board to assist the State Historic Preservation Officer for the following purposes:

- Reviewing the State of Colorado Historic Preservation Plan and Annual Work Programs;
- Reviewing and approving National Register nominations prior to submission to the Secretary of the Interior;
- 3. Reviewing Historic Preservation Certification Applications for National Register eligibility with respect to the Tax Reform Act of 1976, Revenue Act of 1978, and Department of Housing and Urban Development administered historic preservation loan program prior to submission to the Secretary of the Interior;

- 4. Reviewing State Historic Preservation Officer recommended National Historic Landmarks prior to submission to the Governor and the Secretary of the Interior;
  - 5. Reviewing the priorities used in selecting Historic Preservation Fund subgrantee awards;
  - 6. Reviewing the State Historic Preservation Officer recommended Resources Protection Planning Process prior to implementation;
  - 7. Providing general advice, guidance, and professional recommendations to the State Historic Preservation Officer in carrying out the other duties and responsibilities authorized by the National Historic Preservation Act or implementing regulations.

The Historic Preservation State Review Board shall be composed of from twelve to fifteen members appointed by the Governor and serving two year, renewable terms (January through December) as follows:

- 1. The State Historic Preservation Officer shall serve as chairman of the State Review Board:
- 2. The State Review Board shall be represented by at least one recognized professional meeting the requirements defined in 36 Code of Federal Regulations 61.5 (1977) in each of the disciplines of history, prehistoric archaeology, architectural history, architecture, and historical architecture; in addition, the two State Advisors to the National Trust for Historic Preservation shall serve ex officio;
- 3. The State Review Board may be represented by non-professional citizen members with demonstrated interest or competence in historic preservation as long as the majority of membership in the State Review Board consists of recognized professionals.

The State Review Board shall meet at least three times each year to
