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EXECUTIVE ORDER

CREATING THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP TO THE BLUE RIBBON CITIZEN'S COMMITTEE for the LONG RANGE ROCKY FLATS UTILIZATION STUDY

WHEREAS, the Department of Energy is conducting an extensive study on the long range utilization of DOE's Rocky Flats facility; and

WHEREAS, the DOE study will include many technical issues relating to the possible modification and/or relocation of some or all of the Rocky Flats operations; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee has been charged with performing an independent review and evaluation of the DOE study and its conclusions, as well as reporting on the study to local, state, and federal agencies and to the public; and


WHEREAS, the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee has approved the formation of a Technical Advisory Group to assist in the technical evaluation;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the authority vested in me by the constitution and statutes of the State of Colorado, do HEREBY ORDER THAT:

- 1) The Technical Advisory Group for the Long Range Rocky Flats Utilization Study (TAG), previously approved by the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee is hereby created as a subcommittee of the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee.
- 2) The TAG shall assist the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee by providing independent technical review and assessment of the DOE study and shall report to the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee concerning its assessments, conclusions and recommendations. The Committee's executive director shall coordinate the activities of the TAG.
- 3) Members of the TAG shall serve without compensation, but out-of-state members will be reimbursed for travel and per diem expenses according to state fiscal rules, and only out of funds available to the Blue Ribbon Citizen's Committee.

- 4) The TAG shall terminate upon submission of their final written report to the Committee.
