DISSOLUTION OF THE COLORADO 1202 COMMISSION

WHEREAS, 1202 commissions, which were delegated state planning functions, are no longer authorized in the federal Higher Education Act as amended in 1980; and


WHEREAS, The General Assembly has, through Title 23, Article 1 (C.R.S. 1973), established the Colorado Commission on Higher Education to perform certain duties and functions related to planning and coordination of postsecondary education in Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Commission on Higher Education has been designated as the state agency charged to administer programs of the federal Higher Education Act as amended in 1980, including programs formerly delegated to 1202 commissions.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby dissolve the Colorado 1202 Commission. This Executive Order shall supersede the Executive Order of April 20, 1977, establishing the Colorado 1202 Commission. It shall take effect on October 16, 1981.
