## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### STATE JOB TRAINING COORDINATING COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") enacted October 13, 1982, Public Law 97-300, mandates in Section 122(a)(1) the establishment of a State Job Training Coordinating Council; and

WHEREAS, the Act offers the State of Colorado an excellent opportunity to strengthen its economy through the promotion of public/private sector partnership efforts; and

WHEREAS, Section 122(a)(2) of the Act states that the State Job Training Coordinating Council shall be appointed by the Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. There is hereby established a Colorado Job Training Coordinating Council (hereinafter referred to as the "Council") pursuant to Section 122(a)(1) of the Job Training Partnership Act.
2. The Council shall consist of no more than 27 members to be appointed by the Governor.
3. The Council shall be composed of membership in accordance with Section 122(a)(3) of the Act.
  - a. One-third of the membership of the State Council shall be representatives of business and industry (including agriculture, where appropriate) in the State, including individuals who are representatives of business and industry on private industry councils in the State. Not less than twenty percent of the membership of the State Council shall be representatives of the State Legislature and State agencies and organizations. Not less than twenty percent of the membership of the State Council shall be representatives of the units or consortia of units of general local

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government in such State (including those which are administration entities or grantees under this Act) which shall be nominated by the chief executive officers of the units or consortia of units of general local government. Not less than twenty percent of the membership of the State Council shall be representatives of the eligible population and of the general public, representatives of organized labor, representatives of community-based organizations, and representatives of local educational agencies (nominated by local educational agencies).

- b. Members of the Council will serve for terms of three years, but the initial members of the Council will serve for terms of one, two or three years for the orderly periodic turnover of one-third of the Council each year.
  - c. The Council shall terminate on January 1, 1989, unless extended by subsequent Executive Order.
- 4. The Governor shall appoint one non-governmental member to serve as chairperson pursuant to Section 122(a)(2) of the Act.
  - 5. The Council shall meet at least quarterly. Members will be reimbursed for allowable expenses.
  - 6. The Council chairperson shall appoint the chairperson of each of the four standing committees and also may create temporary working committees as the chair deems necessary.
  - 7. The Council shall plan, coordinate and monitor the provision of programs and services authorized by and related to the Act.
  - 8. Pursuant to Section 122(a)(7) of the Act, plans and decisions by the Council shall be subject to approval by the Governor.
  - 9. Pursuant to Section 122(b)(4) of the Act, the Council shall advise and recommend to the Colorado General Assembly improvements of services authorized by or related to the Act.
  - 10. In accordance with Section 122(b) of the Act, the primary duties, responsibilities and functions of the Council shall include recommending to the Governor:
    - a. A Governor's coordination and special services plan.
    - b. Substate service delivery areas.

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- c. Allocation of resources to the Governor pursuant to the Act.
  - d. Guidance, review and certification of state and local job training plans.
  - e. Appropriate coordination, linkages and improvements among employment, training and related programs provided by state and local entities.
11. Pursuant to Section 122(b)(5),(6),(7)(B), and (8) of the Act, report and comment to the Governor.
12. As requested by the Governor, conduct functions related to the Act as provided by Section 122(c) of the Act.
