EXECUTIVE ORDER
DUTIES FOR
STATE JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the State Council on Criminal Justice was abolished through House Bill 1427, which I signed into law on May 18, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado, in accordance with provisions of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 (PL 93-415), needs a Juvenile Justice Council in order to participate in the federal program; and


WHEREAS, the State of Colorado desires to have a Juvenile Justice Council to address juvenile issues and problems;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Council shall be continued with membership as mandated in the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act.
2. The Council shall perform the following functions:
 - a. Advise the Governor on juvenile justice issues and the Division of Criminal Justice in the performance of its duties as related to juvenile justice matters;
 - b. Address pertinent issues and advocate on behalf of positive changes in the juvenile justice system;
 - c. Coordinate with relevant groups and individuals in addressing problems and issues related to the juvenile justice system;
 - d. Review and approve the State Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Plan as required by the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act; and
 - e. Review and approve applications from state, local and private agencies for grant funding as provided by the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention.

This order shall terminate on December 31, 1984, unless extended by Executive Order.
