EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO STATEWIDE HEALTH COORDINATING COUNCIL

ORDERED:

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Colorado, I hereby order and direct that my Executive Order #B01182, of October 12, 1982 establishing the Colorado Statewide Health Coordinating Council, be amended to read as follows:

- 1) the Colorado Statewide Health Coordinating Council (hereafter known as the Council) be created pursuant to Public Law 93-541, the National Health Planning and Resources Development Act of 1973, which may consist of 16 members who shall be appointed by the Governor and one ex-officio member.
 - a. The majority of the members of the Council shall be consumers.
 - b. Each Health Systems Agency shall have a minimum of three representatives and at least half of each Health Systems Agency's representatives shall be consumers. The Governor shall appoint a minimum of five additional representatives of which a majority shall be consumers of health care who are not also providers of health care. Not less than one-third of the providers of health care who are members of the Council shall be direct providers of health care (as described in Section 1531(3)).
