EXECUTIVE ORDER

RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FIRE SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, the State of Colorado is concerned with the lack of fire prevention and protection which affects all citizens by causing death, disfigurement and injuries, and extensive property loss; and
- WHEREAS, the growth in Colorado has placed increased demands on local government in the area of fire prevention and protection; and
- WHEREAS, the National Fire Prevention and Control Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-498) is being implemented by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and national fire groups need an official state contact point for Colorado;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby re-establish the Fire Safety Advisory Committee, in accordance with the following:
 - 1. The Division of Fire Safety within the Department of Public Safety is hereby named and designated to serve as the state coordinator for the National Fire Prevention and Control Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-498). The Fire Safety Advisory Committee shall advise the Division of Fire Safety in carrying out this act.
 - 2. Recommendations from this committee shall be forwarded to the Governor for his consideration.

- The committee shall be composed of one member from each of 3. the following organizations who shall be appointed by each organization: Colorado State Fire Chiefs Association; Fire Marshalls Association of Colorado; Colorado State Fire-fighters Association; Colorado Professional Firefighters Association: Colorado State Fire Training Association; Colorado State Forest Service, Metropolitan Arson Investigators Association; Society of Chartered Property Casualty Underwriters, Colorado Chapter; Colorado Counties, Inc.; Colorado Municipal League; Districts Association of Colorado; Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee; and the Manager of Fire Service Training from the State Board of Community Colleges and Occupational Education. The Chair Shall be elected by the committee. Members shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses associated with the work of the committee.
- 4. This order shall be effective July 1, 1984, and supercedes any previous Executive Orders relating to or establishing a Fire Safety Advisory Committee.
- 5. The committee shall be terminated no later than January 1, 1987, unless renewed by appropriate action of the Governor prior to that date.
