EXECUTIVE ORDER

STATE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE ADVISORY BOARD

- WHEREAS, Public Law 98-473 creates a Justice Assistance program pursuant of Title II, Chapter VI of the Justice Assistance Act of 1984; and
- WHEREAS, the Division of Criminal Justice within the Department of Public Safety has been designated by me to administer and distribute the Justice Assistance funds provided to the State of Colorado; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety wishes to utilize the resources in the State of Colorado to address issues related to Justice Assistance and to provide recommendations on the administration of Justice Assistance funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. There is created, within the Division of Criminal Justice, a State Justice Assistance Advisory Board, which shall consist of 15 members. The Board shall be composed of: three chiefs of police; two sheriffs; the executive director of the Department of Corrections; two district attorneys; a public defender; the state court administrator; the director of the Division of Youth Services; the director of the Colorado Bureau of Investigation; the Chief of the Colorado State Patrol; a legislator; and a district court judge. The chair of the Board and the members shall be appointed by the Governor. Board members shall receive no compensation for their services in performance of their official duties. Any member of the Council may be removed by the Governor for cause.



2. The Council shall perform the following functions:
 - a. Advise the Division of Criminal Justice, Department of Public Safety, on issues related to the Justice Assistance Act of 1984;
 - b. Review the State Justice Assistance Plan;
 - c. Review applications from state and local agencies for funding from the federal victim assistance funds and make recommendations for funding to the Director of the Division of Criminal Justice.
3. The Board shall terminate and terms of the members shall expire no later than January 31, 1987, unless renewed by appropriate action of the Governor prior to that date.
