EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY ADVISORY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, the construction industry is vital to the health of Colorado's economy, providing almost \$2 billion to the economy and over 93,000 jobs annually; and
- WHEREAS, balanced economic development in Colorado requires a strong construction industry; and
- WHEREAS, workers and employers in the construction industry have a mutual interest in strengthening Colorado's construction industry; and
- WHEREAS, representatives of labor and management have requested the establishment of a Colorado Construction Industry Advisory Council to include representation from workers, employers, and government; and
- WHEREAS, such a council is consistent with the interests and priorities of the State of Colorado

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

- 1. There is created a Colorado Construction Industry Advisory Council. The council shall be composed of ten members as follows: the Executive Director of the Department of Labor and Employment, who shall chair the council; the Executive Director of the Department of Local Affairs: two public sector or general public representatives, at least one of whom represents local government; three representatives of construction industry employers; three representatives of industry construction employees. Members appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Members of the council shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses associated with the work of the council.
- 2. The purpose of this council is to:
 - foster expansion of current industries and attraction of new employers to Colorado;
 - b. foster improvemets in the productivity and cost-effectiveness of the Colorado construction industry;

c. advise state and local government on actions to maintain the strength of the construction industry.

Towards these ends, the council shall develop recommendations to:

- a. communicate to industry outside of Colorado our positive economic climate and cooperative labor -management environment, to encourage location in the state;
- b. improve communications between labor and management throughout the construction industry in Colorado;
- c. improve the overall quality of construction, promote safe and healthful work environments, promote productivity, and solve problems related to manpower requirements, training, and apprenticeship;
- d. promote use of Colorado contractors and employees for Colorado construction projects;
- e. streamline licensing and construction permits and enforcement of labor laws, code enforcement, and health and safety requirements;
- f. resolve other problems of mutual concern to the council members.
- State officials shall cooperate fully with the council in pursuing its work. Staff assistance shall be provided by the Department of Labor and Employment.
- 4. The council shall provide to the Governor by June 30 of each year a report on their activities and results of those activities.
- 5. The Colorado Construction Industry Advisory Council shall be terminated not later than January 31, 1989, unless reviewed by the Governor for appropriate action prior to that date.
