EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the construction industry is vital to the health of Colorado's economy, providing almost \$2 billion to the economy and over 93,000 jobs annually; and

WHEREAS, balanced economic development in Colorado requires a strong construction industry; and

WHEREAS, workers and employers in the construction industry have a mutual interest in strengthening Colorado's construction industry; and

WHEREAS, representatives of labor and management have requested the establishment of a Colorado Construction Industry Advisory Council to include representation from workers, employers, and government; and

WHEREAS, such a council is consistent with the interests and priorities of the State of Colorado

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. There is created a Colorado Construction Industry Advisory Council. The council shall be composed of ten members as follows: the Executive Director of the Department of Labor and Employment, who shall chair the council; the Executive Director of the Department of Local Affairs; two public sector or general public representatives, at least one of whom represents local government; three representatives of construction industry employers; three representatives of construction industry employees. Members shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Members of the council shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses associated with the work of the council.
2. The purpose of this council is to:
 - a. foster expansion of current industries and attraction of new employers to Colorado;
 - b. foster improvements in the productivity and cost-effectiveness of the Colorado construction industry;
