EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO BICYCLING ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Bicycling is a pollution-free, healthful, energy efficient means of transportation and recreation; and

WHEREAS, Bicycling is recognized by both State and Federal Law and the policies and programs of federal, state and local transportation agencies as a legitimate mode of transportation; and

WHEREAS, Colorado has an international reputation for bicycling as a sport and form of recreational tourism; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public's interest in Colorado to encourage bicycling as a form of exercise, transportation and recreation to increase health and fitness, decrease air pollution and provide quality leisure activity; and

WHEREAS, it is instrumental to the welfare of the residents of Colorado to update laws and educational programs on reference to bicycling on public roads; and


WHEREAS, it is in the economic interest of the State of Colorado to encourage and provide for non-residents to visit Colorado for the purpose of bicycle racing, touring or other bicycling activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT,

1. There is created a Colorado Bicycling Advisory Board which shall consist of at least 12, but not more than 15 members. The Chair of the Board and members shall be appointed by the Governor and serve for terms of two years. The Board shall be composed of members with interest and knowledge in bicycling. Members shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses. Any member of the Board may be removed by the Governor for cause.

2. The function of the Board shall be to identify and address the needs of bicycling and recommend to the appropriate agencies, entities, or individuals, ways to address those needs.
3. The Board shall meet at times and places as designated by the Chair. Staff assistance shall be provided by the Department of Highways. The Board shall submit preliminary findings and recommendations to the Governor no later than one year after its inaugural meeting.
4. The Colorado Bicycling Advisory Board shall be terminated not later than July 1, 1989, unless reviewed by the Governor for appropriate action prior to that date.
