EXECUTIVE ORDER

GOVERNOR'S SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, the State of Colorado's future is closely tied to the quality of the intellectual, scientific, environmental, and infrastructure resources of the State; and
- WHEREAS, the complexity of the issues confronting the State requires inputs from the array of high quality expertise available in the State; and
- WHEREAS, education and public awareness as they relate to scientific and technological issues are the basis for new achievements in economic growth, while maintaining a higher quality of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The Governor's Science and Technology Advisory Council is re-established to have the following purposes:
 - a. to provide regular linkages between the Executive Branch of State Government and the research activities and expertise available within all sectors of the State;
 - b. to identify key problems and opportunities on the horizon for Colorado and to call these problems and opportunities to the attention of the Executive Branch;
 - c. to identify the research and educational strengths within the State, including networking opportunities among the private sector, state and federal institutions, and to advise the Executive Branch on strategies for capitalizing on these strengths;
 - d. to provide advice on particular issues as requested by the Governor and Cabinet, and to act as a sounding board for State agency programs and procedures;
 - e. to provide issue papers and task force reports on matters of importance to the State, utilizing appropriate expertise.
