GOVERNOR'S REVENUE ESTIMATING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the preparation of revenue forecasts, is central to the operation of the Colorado State government; and

WHEREAS, the division of budgeting must prepare an annual general fund revenue estimate (C.R.S. 24-37-405); and

whereas, the Office of State Planning and Budgeting must provide the General Assembly with a general fund revenue estimate by March 15 of each year for the next fiscal year of the state (C.R.S. 24-75-201.3); and

WHEREAS, it would benefit the State to have outside, objective review of revenue estimates and underlying economic assumptions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

- 1. There is established a Governor's Revenue Estimating Advisory Committee (hereinafter known as the Committee). The Committee shall be composed of: The executive director of the Colorado Department of Revenue; the director of the Office of State Planning and Budgeting; the director of the Legislative Council staff and the State Treasurer. The remaining members shall not be employed by the State of Colorado and should possess skills in analyzing state revenues, or the economic variables that affect the revenue estimate. Members shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Committee members shall receive no compensation for their services in performances of their official duties.
- 2. The Committee shall meet at times and places as designated by Office of State Planning and Budgeting, but in no event less than quarterly.

- The Committee shall perform the following functions: 3.
  - Examine, review, and critique the economic assumptions and forecasts that are used in preparation of a estimate. The Committee should. revenue qi ve particular attention to the economic variables that are used in producing a revenue estimate. Committee shall also review the impact of federal and state law changes on state revenues. The Committee shall be aware of the components of the revenue estimating process and the models developed.
- This Order supercedes any previous Executive Orders relating to or establishing a Governor's Revenue Estimating Advisory Committee.
