EXECUTIVE ORDER

STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado, in accordance with provisions of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 (PL 93-415, the "Act"), needs a Juvenile Justice Council in order to participate in the federal program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado desires to have a Juvenile Justice Council to address juvenile issues and problems;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The State Advisory Council on Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention shall be continued with membership as mandated in the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act. Members shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
2. The State Advisory Council on Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention is designated as the supervisory board pursuant to the Act and the Division of Criminal Justice is designated as the State Agency pursuant to the Act.
3. The Council shall perform the following functions:
 - a. Advise the Governor and the Division of Criminal Justice on juvenile justice issues;
 - b. Review pertinent issues and make appropriate recommendations to the Department of Public Safety in accordance with the state plan on behalf of positive changes in the juvenile justice system;
 - c. Coordinate with relevant groups and individuals in addressing problems and issues related to the juvenile justice system;
