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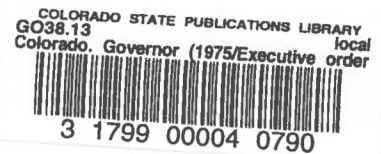

EXECUTIVE ORDER

THE ASSIGNMENT OF CARTOGRAPHIC RESPONSIBILITIES AND INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE COLORADO MAPPING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the second session of the Forty-Ninth General Assembly has authorized the Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs, to enter into a cooperative mapping agreement with the Geological Survey, U.S. Department of the Interior, and to contract for state-wide photographic coverage; and

WHEREAS, several State agencies and regional, county, local and private organizations are users of cartographic and aerial photographic resources; and

WHEREAS, there is a requirement for cartographic standards and specifications for State agencies, regional, county and local organizations; and

WHEREAS, the State Cartographer has been assigned to the Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby direct:

1. The Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs, shall be responsible for the following cartographic duties:
 - a. Consult, advise and assist State agencies and regional, county and local organizations on cartographic and aerial photographic resources and provide technical assistance on the utilization of these resources;
 - b. Coordinate and monitor cooperative mapping agreements among government agencies and provide liaison between the Colorado map-using community and the Federal map-making community.
 - c. Provide official base maps and maintain indexes of cartographic and aerial photographic resources;
 - d. Provide state-wide, high-altitude aerial photographic coverage and coordinate regional aerial photographic projects;
 - e. Coordinate high-altitude remote sensing projects;
 - f. Develop and maintain standards and criteria for the cartographic display of automated mapping and geo-coding systems; and
 - g. Coordinate the preparation of budgets for all State mapping needs.
