PASSENGER TRAMWAY SAFETY HEARINGS

INDEX

WHEREAS

The Colorado Ski Industry significantly affects the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the State; and

WHEREAS

Heretofore, the Colorado Ski Industry has enjoyed the reputation of maintaining an excellent safety record relative to other states providing similar recreational activities; and

WHEREAS

It is an ongoing State policy to prevent unnecessary mechanical hazards in the operation of ski tows, lifts and tramways, to assure that reasonable design and construction methods are employed and that accepted safety devices and sufficient personnel are provided for, and that periodic inspections and adjustments are made which are deemed essential to the safe operation of such devices; and

WHEREAS

Such State policy can best be promoted by systematically obtaining views and information from citizens concerned with Ski Industry safety;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby establish the following:

- The Executive Director of the Department of Regulatory Agencies, Raul N.
 Rodriguez, shall empanel a committee and convene three public hearings,
 to be held in Denver, Breckenridge, and Aspen respectively, for the purpose
 of obtaining views and information from citizens concerned with Colorado
 Ski Industry safety.
- 2. At such hearings it shall be the duty of the committee to identify safety hazards and methods of preventing such hazardous conditions by considering testimony of the public relating to the express and limited subject of Passenger Tramway Safety including: design, construction, operation, inspection, reporting of accidents, and all other subjects specifically affecting citizen safety.

3. The results of the committee's findings shall be made public and transferred to the Passenger Tramway Safety Board for consideration in revising board rules and regulations, in reviewing legislation, and in all other activities requiring such information.

- 3) safety devices and sufficient personnel to be provided;
