EXECUTIVE ORDER

- WHEREAS, the State Services Building, 1525 Sherman Street, suffered a break in the water main of said building; and
- WHEREAS, said break has caused major damage and loss of water such that sanitary and other health and safety conditions of the State Services Building may cause a serious danger to the public health of the state employees, occupants, and visitors to the building prior to the repair of the water main; and
- WHEREAS, I have conducted a thorough investigation and evaluation of the situation; and
- WHEREAS, as Governor, I am authorized pursuant to C.R.S. 1973, 24-20-108, to prevent or minimize any risk of serious danger to the public health from arising;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, in order to prevent and minimize the risk of serious danger to the public health, do hereby order as follows:
1. That the State Services Building, 1525 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado, be closed until Wednesday, November 30, 1977, or until such future date I may hereafter proclaim.
 2. The state officials and employees who are employed in the State Services Building may not work within said building until Wednesday, November 30, 1977, or until such future date I may hereafter order.
 3. All time taken away from the pursuit of public duties by virtue of this order shall be considered as administrative leave.
