EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Attorney General of the State of Colorado has received certain information indicating that persons and corporations engaged in the sale of roofing materials in the State of Colorado may have violated certain statutes of the State of Colorado including, but not limited to, the State antitrust laws, C.R.S. 1973, 6-4-101 et seq; and

WHEREAS, it appears from preliminary investigation that certain persons and corporations engaged in the sale of roofing materials in the State of Colorado may have violated certain statutes of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the best interests of the People of the State of Colorado require that the Attorney General take prompt and vigorous action in order to protect the public interest of the State of Colorado;

NOW, THEREFORE, under and pursuant to the authority invested in me by title 24, article 31, section 101, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, 1973, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby request you, the Attorney General of the State of Colorado, investigate and, should the State Grand Jury return indictments, prosecute to completion any and all violations of statutes of the State of Colorado relating to the aforementioned investigation. You are further requested to initiate and prosecute to completion any appropriate civil action, including but not limited to an action under 15 U.S.C. §§ 15, 15c or 26, for any damages incurred by the State of Colorado or any political subdivisions or citizens thereof and for injunctive relief to prevent repetition of the conduct in question.
