EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, a petition for the recall of Joseph E. Losavio, Jr., as District Attorney for the Tenth Judicial District, State of Colorado, was submitted to Mary Estill Buchanan, Colorado Secretary of State, for her inspection on January 26, 1978; and

WHEREAS, after inspection, the Secretary of State on February 1, 1978 accepted the petition for filing; and

WHEREAS, a protest to the sufficiency of the recall petition was filed by J. E. Losavio, Jr., James A. Lowe, Charles Malouff, and Clinton A. Smith; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State conducted a hearing on said protest on February 24, 28, and March 1, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State has found the petition to recall Joseph E. Losavio, Jr., to be sufficient under Article XXI of the Colorado Constitution so as to require Joseph E. Losavio, Jr., as District Attorney for the Tenth Judicial District of the State of Colorado, to be subject to a recall election; and

WHEREAS, I have received from the Secretary of State the petition for recall and her certificate as to the sufficiency thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Article XXI, Section 2 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby order and direct that a recall election for Joseph E. Losavio, Jr., as District Attorney for the Tenth Judicial District, State of Colorado, be held on the 27 day of April, 1978. Such recall election shall be conducted pursuant to Article XXI, Section 3 of the Colorado Constitution.
