## EXECUTIVE ORDER

ESTABLISHMENT OF A POLICY THAT WORKING HOURS ARRANGED FOR STATE EMPLOYEES NOT BE RANDOMLY CHANGED BY SUPERVISORS IN ORGANIZATIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, it is essential to improvement of air quality and energy conservation that miles of travel by petroleum-fueled vehicles be reduced; and

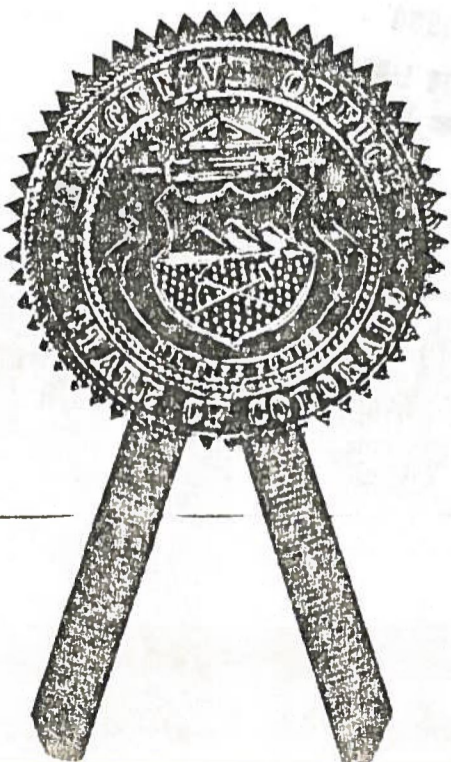
WHEREAS, use of buses, vanpools, and carpools significantly contributes to reduction of vehicle miles travelled; and

WHEREAS, the success of high-occupancy vehicle programs depends upon on-time release of employees from their jobs so that they may meet vehicle departure time schedules; and

WHEREAS, routine release of employees from their jobs at quitting times designated for them is consistent with my Executive Order of June 10, 1977, urging all State of Colorado appointing authorities to utilize flexitime,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby direct that all supervisors within State agencies arrange work schedules to enable their employees to fully avail themselves of opportunities to utilize high-occupancy vehicles.
