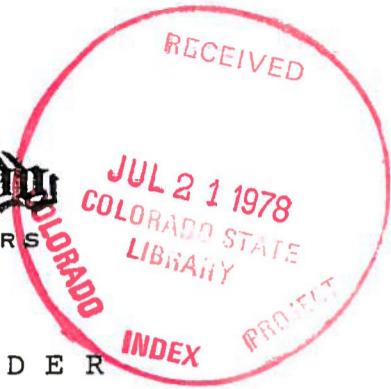

E X E C U T I V E O R D E R

THE ASSIGNMENT OF CARTOGRAPHIC RESPONSIBILITIES AND
INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE COLORADO MAPPING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the second session of the Forty-Ninth General Assembly has authorized the Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs, to enter into a cooperative mapping agreement with the Geological Survey, U.S. Department of the Interior, and to contract for statewide photographic coverage; and

WHEREAS, several State agencies and regional, county, local and private organizations are users of cartographic and aerial photographic resources; and

WHEREAS, there is a requirement for cartographic standards and specifications for State agencies, regional, county and local organizations; and

WHEREAS, the State Cartographer has been assigned to the Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby direct:

1. The Division of Planning, Department of Local Affairs, shall be responsible for the following cartographic duties:
 - A. Consult, advise and assist State agencies and regional, county and local organizations on cartographic and aerial photographic resources and provide technical assistance on the utilization of these resources;
 - B. Coordinate and monitor cooperative mapping agreements among government agencies and provide liaison between the Colorado mapping community and the Federal map-making community;
 - C. Provide official base maps and maintain indexes of cartographic and aerial photographic resources;
 - D. Provide statewide, high-altitude aerial photographic coverage and coordinate regional aerial photographic projects;
 - E. Coordinate high-altitude remote sensing projects;
