EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by Title 28, Article 2 of the Colorado Revised Statutes 1973, as amended, I hereby renew and extend, for Thirty (30) days, the Executive Order - Proclamation dated July 8, 1978, declaring a disaster emergency due to grasshopper infestation.

The Colorado Department of Agriculture will continue to be charged with determining what further steps need be taken to control this problem. The following counties will be eligible for participation in any infestation eradication programs determined necessary by the Colorado Department of Agriculture, subject to participation requirements determined by the Commissioner of Agriculture:

Baca, Bent, Cheyenne, Crowley, Custer, Kiowa, Kit Carson, Las Animas, Lincoln, Logan, Morgan, Otero, Phillips, Prowers, Pueblo, Sedgwick, Washington, Yuma, and Weld.

All elements of the July 8, 1978 Executive Order - Proclamation not in conflict with subsequent legislative determinations remain in force for the duration of this Executive Order.
