## EXECUTIVE ORDER

Concerning Budget Expenditures  
of the Office of the Lt. Governor

WHEREAS, I Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, have previously issued an Executive Order dated November 1, 1977, which provides policies and procedures to insure compliance with Appropriation Acts; and

WHEREAS, the State Controller and State Budget Director have advised that a projected overexpenditures exists in the Lt. Governor's Administration Line Item Appropriation between \$6,500 and \$8,500 for the six-month period ending December 31, 1978, plus the first nine days of January, 1979;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, including C.R.S. 1973, 24-37-403 and 406, as amended, do hereby direct the Lt. Governor to take immediate steps to insure that total expenditures for the period ended January 9, 1979, do not exceed an allotted appropriation of \$61,766 for the Lt. Governor's Administration Line Item.

I further direct the State Controller to approve vouchers and issue warrants only for expenditures incurred by the Lt. Governor's Office for the period ending January 9, 1979, in an amount not to exceed \$61,766.

This Order shall be effective the first day of December, 1978.
