

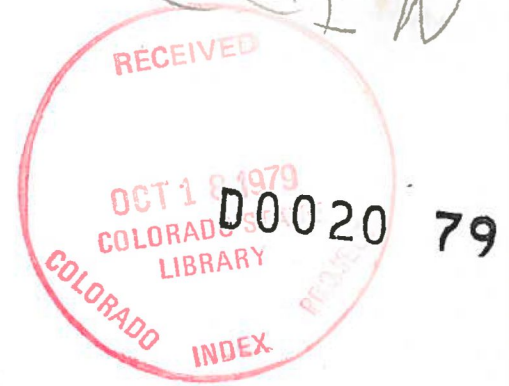

EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, on April 20, 1979, Mr. Gordon Heggie was placed on temporary leave from his duties as Chairman of the Parole Board so that he could head the Governor's Sentencing Review Committee; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Dan Grove was directed to assume the responsibilities of Chairman of the Parole Board during Mr. Heggie's leave; and

WHEREAS, the work of the Sentencing Review Committee is substantially complete, although continuing activity will be required on a periodic basis for several more months;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me, it is ORDERED THAT:

1. Mr. Gordon Heggie shall resume his duties as Chairman of the Parole Board on October 15, 1979.
2. On October 15, 1979, Mr. Dan Grove shall no longer perform the responsibilities of Chairman of the Parole Board, and he shall resume his duties as a regular member of the Parole Board.
3. Mr. Heggie shall continue to be the head of the Governor's Sentencing Review Committee, devoting sufficient time to ensure the required work of that Committee is completed in a timely fashion. In no event shall Mr. Heggie spend more than two (2) working days in any single workweek nor more than six (6) working days in any single month on his duties as head of the Sentencing Review Committee.
