## EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, an emergency disaster situation exists in Logan County, State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, strict compliance with regulatory statutes, regulations, rules, and orders would prevent operations required to deal with this emergency situation, and suspension of statutes, regulations, and rules are necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the general public; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to utilize available resources of the State government as reasonably necessary to cope with the disaster emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, to implement my Disaster Emergency Proclamation of November 29, 1979, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under powers vested in me under Section 28-2-104 of the Disaster Emergency Act and all other enabling provisions, suspend the operation of regulatory statutes, rules and regulations relating to the budgeting of state highway funds, and in particular C.R.S. 1973, 43-1-105 (g), and do hereby authorize the State Department of Highways to take all necessary actions, including the expenditure of state highway funds, to restore access on county roads located within the affected county.

This Executive Order shall continue for thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended by me.
