WHEREAS, the winter of 1979-80 has produced an abundance of such weather; and

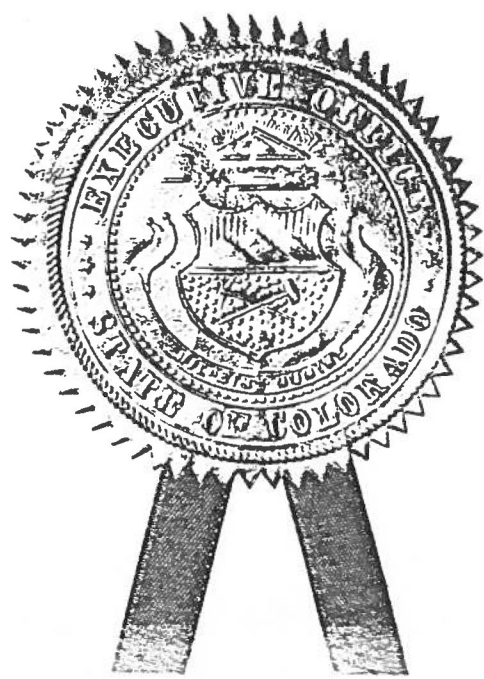
