EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO STATE PATROL TO ASSIST DENVER POLICE DEPARTMENT DURING NATIONAL GOVERNORS' CONFERENCE

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado is acting as host for the 1980 National Governors' Conference; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the City of Denver has requested the assistance of the Colorado State Patrol in providing security for that Conference;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby order and direct that:

1. The Chief of the Colorado State Patrol shall assign such officers as deemed appropriate to provide security and to perform such duties as are required in conjunction with the National Governors' Conference to be held in Denver, Colorado, August 3 through August 5, 1980.
2. The Chief of the Colorado State Patrol shall coordinate the activities of all officers assigned to this detail with the Chief of the Police Department for the City of Denver.
3. The authority granted to the Colorado State Patrol by this order shall take effect on July 29, 1980, and shall expire on August 7, 1980.
4. This order supercedes any other applicable Executive Orders authorizing the Colorado State Patrol to assist the Police Department of the City of Denver for the period during which this order is effective.
