EXECUTIVE ORDER

RENEWAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS

WHEREAS, by virtue of Proclamations dated May 10, 1980, and May 30, 1980, an emergency disaster situation was declared to exist for the Counties of Larimer, Weld, Logan, Morgan, Sedgwick and Washington, State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of Executive Orders dated May 21, 1980, and May 30, 1980, under said Proclamations, the operation of regulatory statutes, rules and regulations relating to the implementation of procedures developed by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services for disbursing monies from the Disaster Emergency Fund, were suspended; and

WHEREAS, said Executive Orders shall no longer be effective after expiration of said Proclamations; and

WHEREAS, said Proclamations are being renewed by order dated June 30, 1980, for an additional thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do find that it is necessary to continue to suspend the aforementioned statutes, rules, regulations and order to cope with the disaster emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, to implement my proclamations of May 10, 1980, and May 30, 1980, as extended, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under powers vested in me under CRS 1973, 28-2-104 and 28-2-502 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, and all other enabling provisions do hereby renew my Executive Orders of May 21, 1980, and May 30, 1980, for so long as my Proclamations of May 10, 1980, and May 30, 1980, are in full force and effect.
